Frequently Asked Questions

How much money can I receive from Dundalk Renaissance Corporation?

You can receive up to \$5,000 for exterior improvements to their homes.

Is there a matching requirement for this grant?

There is no matching requirement for this grant.

What kind of renovations can my funds be used for?

The funds must be used for exterior improvements and repairs to the front of the home or visible side yard. All projects must be used for capital improvements to the property. Eligible improvements include but not limited to replacing doors or windows, repairing stucco/siding, lighting, hardscaping, roof repairs. *Ineligible improvements include landscaping.*

Who is eligible to apply for this grant?

All home owners or tenants with consent from the property owner on Colgate Avenue in St. Helena, Sollers Point Road in Turner Station, and Shipway in Old Dundalk. Grants are on a first come, first served basis.

What must I submit? You must submit a completed application form.

Will DRC manage my project?

DRC will hire a license contractor and supervise the work being performed. DRC will do 3 inspections during the duration of the project (beginning, middle, and completion) to ensure that the funds are being used properly. The homeowner should feel free to call DRC at any time for questions and concerns.

How will the funds be distributed?

Contractors will submit invoices of the completed work to the Dundalk Renaissance Corporation. The Dundalk Renaissance Corporation will pay the contractors directly up to \$5,000.

Do I have to pay back the grant?

No.
